Below is a more detailed description of each committee and how it helps the St. Michael's community. If you have questions, please don't hesitate to contact the committee chair. Committee	Helping throughout the year
Playground Monitors	Pick the day(s) on a weekly or bi-weekly basis, or even once a month, to assist hired monitors and teachers to supervise lunchtime play in the park from 11:15 a.m. to 12:30 p.m. Chair will set up a monthly schedule. This is a great way to get to know your child's classmates and enjoy time with your child(ren)."
Room Parents	Coordinate class parties; recruit other parents for special activities; attend SMA meetings; help facilitate the class art project for Art Expo; plan the teacher gifts (Dec. & May); manage class funds. Ideally there will be only two lead room parents, but they will always seek additional help.
Hospitality Events	Help "host" important school events. These have included Kinder Orientation, Open Houses, Family Fundraising dinners and other family fun events.
Back up Bakers	Provide baked treats three or four times per year for special events like Grandparents Day, Love of Reading week, and Teacher Appreciation.
Campus Decoration	Making our campus festive for major holidays and seasons (Back to School, Halloween, Christmas, Spring, etc.) Help is needed for putting up and taking down decorations.
Spring Fundraiser	Usually this is a dinner that includes a silent and live auction. Help is needed to plan, gather auction items, and set-up this event. The event is only one day, but the planning takes months.
Arts Programs	Help with one or more Arts Events: Coffee Cabaret, Luminaria Holiday Program, Fine Arts Nights, and Art Expo. Help could include planning, setting up, during the event, and cleaning up.

Committee	Helping on a schedule
Uniform Exchange	Dates are TBD, but tentative dates have been set for late July and early August. An additional date will be set for a "winter" exchange. Help sort clothing, set up, and work at the uniform exchange(s).
Free Money (2x/yr)	Help with the Fall or Spring Box Tops competition. Also, help find and promote other programs that bring profits to the school (ex: Amazon Smile, Mabel's Labels, Fry's reward)
Holiday Greens	A fundraiser where help is needed in organizing the orders and payments in November; then delivering items to classrooms in December.
Math-a-thon	Math-a-thon helpers will collate pledge packets, help administer and correct tests, collect funds, and help with the school wide reward (usually an Eegees party after school). This fundraiser has been a great money raising endeavor for classroom technology.
Pancake Lunch - Mardi Gras	A St. Michael's tradition! Help prepare, cook and/or serve our free pancake lunch to our school community in preparation of Lent. This is a big party event for the kids.
Love of Reading Week	Planning fun "love of reading" activities including visits from authors, guest speakers/readers, book donation effort and more. Ideas welcome.
Book Fair	St. Michael's hosts a Scholastic Book Fair. Help is needed for set-up, sales/cashiers, and break-down. There are many opportunities to help, even if you only have an hour.
Fine Arts Flowers	Helping to process flower orders the weeks prior to Fine Arts Nights and prepare the flowers for distribution the evenings of the Fine Arts Night performance..
Teacher Appreciation	This is a week of showing our amazing teachers how much we appreciate them. Events change yearly, but help may include: donating food/beverage items, helping decorate, or setting up various events (cookie bar, soup lunch bar, dinner take-home, breakfast).
