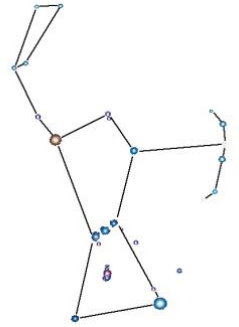


St. Michael's School 2nd Annual Astronomy Night
