## **Qualifications**

All interested candidates should have a Bachelor's degree in elementary education (advanced study and/or Master's degree is preferred) and two or more years of elementary classroom teaching experience. Strong relationship-building skills with students, parents, and colleagues, sound instructional and planning pedagogy, and openness to growth are essential habits of mind and character for faculty candidates. St. Michael's School faculty are expected to maintain a structured, engaging, and challenging learning environment within a student-centered classroom.

Additionally, because of our team approach to grade-level planning, candidates must have strong collaborative skills and be able to work closely with colleagues on curriculum development and instructional planning. The candidate will be expected to participate regularly in professional development with Lower School colleagues, be available to support students and parents before and after school, and may be assigned other duties by the Lower School Director or the Head of School.

## **Compensation and Benefits**

Salary is highly competitive with area schools, commensurate with years of experience and educational background, and negotiable within established ranges. All full-time faculty enjoy benefits that include ~80 days of paid vacation each year, corresponding to our academic calendar with summer break; additional personal and sick-leave days to be used as needed; plus comprehensive health coverage through Blue Cross Blue Shield; dental coverage; and a matching-contribution program for retirement.

School St. Michael's School in Tucson, Arizona, is an Episcopal parish-affiliated K-8 co-educational day school enrolling approximately 290 students. Located 20 minutes from downtown Tucson in the Harold Bell Wright neighborhood, the historical eight-acre campus was originally designed by the renowned Tucson architect Josias Joesler, and is shared with St. Michael and All Angels Church.

St. Michael's School has nurtured the hearts and minds of students since 1960. As an integral part of St. Michael and All Angels Parish, the School expects and promotes the individual's active commitment to personal integrity, service, and academic excellence.
