Committee Descriptions

Year-Round Committees

Campus Decorations (1-2 hours) <i>Spruce up campus seasonally (Back to School, Halloween, Christmas, Spring). Set-up and take-down help needed.</i>
Hospitality (1-2 hours) <i>Assist with set-up and refreshments for school events like Welcome Back Night, Kindergarten Orientation, Open House, etc. Serve as "Back-up Bakers" to provide goodies for class projects and school events (3-4 times a year).</i>
Lunch Program (1.5 hours/shift) <i>Distribute pre-packaged meal orders at lunchtime & earn a discount toward your student's lunches. Only an hour a day for as many (or as few) shifts as you'd like.</i>
Playground Monitors (1.5 hours/shift) <i>Pick the day(s) that work for you to assist hired monitors and teachers in supervising lunchtime play in the park from 11:15am-12:30pm. Shifts will be scheduled on a monthly calendar. A great way to get to know students and spend time with your child at school!</i>
Room Parents (1-2 hours/week) <i>Assist the teacher with in-class parties & projects, recruiting volunteers as needed. Attend monthly SMAV meetings and communicate class & school news with parents. Oversee class budget and give teacher gifts at year-end.</i>
Vaqueros (Men's Group) <i>One part social club, one part muscle for hire at school events for set-up/break-down, bar tending, stage building, etc.</i>

Event Committees

Uniform Exchange <i>Fall & Spring (1-2 hours)</i> Gently-used uniforms are collected, sorted and sold twice a year – a valued event for families and a wonderful fundraiser for SMAV. Help organize the exchange and/or work a shift at the event.
Grandparent's Day (Virtual) <i>October (2-3 hours)</i> Create a video presentation that allows grandparents to virtually visit their grandchildren at school and see how teachers and students have adapted to this unique year.
Math-a-thon Student Fundraiser <i>February 8-26 (1-2hours)</i> Students actively participate in Philanthropy to support St. Michael's during this annual event that culminates in a school-wide celebration.
Mardi Gras Pancake Lunch <i>February 16 (3-4 hours)</i> A St. Michael's tradition! School-wide free pancake lunch, complete with Mardi Gras beads and live music by a steel drum band in Creswell Courtyard – all in anticipation of the beginning of Lent. Help prepare, cook and/or serve pancakes at this unique celebration.
Love of Reading & Book Fair <i>March 8-12(2-3 hours)</i> Help plan events to inspire the "love of reading" such as visits from authors and guest readers, door decoration contests and a book donation drive. OR help with the Scholastic Book Fair – setup/breakdown or working a shift during the Fair.
Fine Arts Flowers <i>March (2-3 hours)</i> Process orders in advance, prepare flowers before the event and help distribute to families at Fine Arts Night. An appreciated service to parents and a good fundraiser as well!
Spring Event / Gala <i>Planning in January/February/March – Event on March 20 (3-6 hours)</i> Add your style and ideas to the party of the year – St. Michael's adults-only night out on campus! Help choose a theme, layout, decorations, food, drinks, live music and auction items to make it a fun social event and successful fundraiser.
Teacher Appreciation <i>May 3-7</i> Help plan and roll out a week's worth of events to celebrate our teachers! Prior years included breakfast, a cookie bar, soup lunch, dinner take-out.
